From Mississippian, towns and buildings alike, same moral beliefs, Green Corn ceremony (celebrated corn and fire, cleaned houses, divorced, mend grudges except murder), matrilineal (children belonged to the women's family, deer-skinned clothes, apron skirts, animal meat and corn, squash, pumpkins, believed that no one owned the land, "eye for an eye" punishment, dome houses made of mud and sticks
